<p>1. Download application form attached.</p>	
<p>2. Complete application form</p>	
<p>3. Write essay that describes your involvement and interest in stamp collecting. Include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What influenced you to begin stamp collecting? • In your opinion, what are the best things about stamp collecting? • How have you been involved in the hobby? • What do you hope to gain from being a Fellow? <p>Essay should be typed, double-spaced, and not more than 4 pages in length.</p>	
<p>4. Ask two individuals to complete a <i>Letter of Recommendation</i> form. One reference must be an educator or academic advisor. Neither reference may be a family member.</p> <p>Before giving the form to the reference, place your name on the “Applicant’s Name” line. Include a stamped, addressed envelope with the form.</p> <p>Completed reference forms can either be submitted by the individual completing the reference form or by the applicant with the application materials.</p>	
<p>5. Applicant should sign the application form. Signatures should be witnessed. Witness should also sign the form in the appropriate place.</p> <p>Applicants aged 16 or 17 must complete that “Parent/Guardian Agreement” section of the application. A parent or guardian’s signature is required.</p>
